Following is a basic rundown of the agenda for the day.

The registration will be in the main building (the one with the flags out front) starting at 7:30ish. There will be an opening ceremony at 8:00 in the theatre which is also in the main building. We will do the pledge of allegiance and flag ceremony and such with some general announcements and some Q and A. The morning merit badge session begins at 8:15 am. Each session should last about 3 and half hours. There are some open areas for boys that finish their sessions early including an open gym, game room, Student Center and hopefully the library with internet access etc. The college asked me to make sure we didn't have boys walking around with nothing to do. Parents and leaders can help out with that.

We break for lunch a little before noon and will have lunch in the student center. Lunch will be: pizza, bug juice (kool aid) and **a** cookie (**a** means **1**). Lunch is included with the registration fee. Our troop's affiliated young women's group will be selling a much wider variety of snack food and drinks for an additional fee.

The afternoon merit badge session begins at 12:15 pm and will continue until around 4 pm. There is no closing ceremony. You are free to go as soon as you finish with your merit badge session. Don't forget to get your blue cards (or whatever) signed off.

Many of our merit badge councilors are bona fide college professors and community leaders that are using the resources of the institution including some student assistance in bringing these opportunities to light.
